ARRL FIELD DAY MISSION

- Amateur radio's open house to demonstrate how amateur radio works reliably under any conditions from almost any location to create an independent communications network
- Largest all-volunteer radio communications exercise in the world, over 18,000 hams participate from thousands of locations (field and homes) across North America
- Consists of over 1,500 public outdoor stations, many organized by radio clubs
- An opportunity to show the public who we are and what assets we bring to our communities for emergency communications
- Ham radio can function independent of the Internet or cell phone infrastructure, can interface with laptops or smartphones, and can be set up almost anywhere in minutes
- Many clubs treat this weekend event as a contesting opportunity



Having Field Day Fun

- 1. Have fun ...it's a hobby (a game of sorts)
- 2. Listen, Listen, then listen some more!
- 3. Patience!!! Before throwing your call sign out (W0TLM) and stomp on other callers. Try listening to the other callers and the rhythm of the Field Day operator's response. This will give you better idea of when to pounce with your call. Sometimes it's at the end after everyone has called or sometimes at the beginning of the pile up
- 4. Be respectful, don't transmit on top of others whenever possible
- 5. Be courteous! (Your mother may be listening)
- 6. This activity will polish your Operating (OP) skills and improve your ability to handle communications traffic in the event of an emergency ...yours or the communities ...remember we are communicators first not just "hams"
- 7. Have fun!

- Come in Main Park Entrance off of Stella Dr.
 (2110 Stella Dr.)
- Turn right to Oak Meadows Area
- •Take 1st Left to parking lot





Fox Run Regional Park is located approximately three miles east of interstate 25 on Baytist Road. Yisitors will find a restud environment among the thick torsat of pendenose pines. Timber Ridge provides an overbook of Repen and Spiruce Lakes as well are a picture squeezolding of Pilose Peak as the mountain backforp. For kingests will enjoy four miles of millituse trails that which through the Fallen Timbers area, pavilions, plaggrounds, and Wedding Gazebo on the lake.






- ENTER FOX RUN REGIONAL PARK FROM STELLA DRIVE OFF OF ROLLER COASTER ROAD

- TURN LEFT INTO PARKING AREA






- ENTER FOX RUN REGIONAL PARK FROM STELLA

- PAVILION 2 IS UP THE HILL IN THE TREES











Driving Directions:
Fox Run Regional park can be reached from Interstate 35, exit 195A to Northgate Road; east on Northgate Road for 3.5 miles; north on Roller Coaster Road for 1/2-mile to Stella Drive; West on Stella Drive.

Or, the park can be reached from Highway 24, North on Highway 83; west on Northgate Road for .5 mile; north on Roller Coaster Road 1.5 miles to Stella Drive.
