


- By 1902 Guglielmo Marconi had demonstrated practical communications across the Atlantic via Radio
- 1912 US Congress passes "Radio Act"; US Amateurs restricted to bands less than 200 Meters, 1 Kilowatt power; license required to operate.
- 1914 The ARRL is organized by Hiram P. Maxim by setting up 'Relay' stations to send messages across the U.S.
